

Accommodations to Facilitate Worship inside CV Building

Sept 20, 2020

1. Initially, no advance registration is required for worship.
2. Building access through two front doors only (portico and porch). Back of building, halls, kitchen, fellowship hall, playground doors, classrooms and 2nd floor are secured. Back doors remain locked (emergency exit possible).
3. Worship area, foyer, front hall and bathrooms sanitized with commercial anti-viral product before and after service.
4. Masks are mandatory including children above 2 years of age. Masks will be provided for those needing them. (Speakers at podium need not be masked.)
5. Social distancing practiced in seating. Sit by families with seating every other pew. Stagger seating across the main aisle.
6. Provide separate seating areas in auditorium for families with children and for higher risk families.
7. Provide special section in auditorium for visitors and for members that may have recently traveled out of town/state/country.
8. Temperature checks are required before entering foyer. Encourage personal responsibility and respect for others by not attending in person if sick.
9. Provide trained ushers to seat, help and guide those attending worship.
10. Signage will be utilized explaining expectations for worship – also post expectations on Facebook page and CV website.
11. All three front restrooms available for emergency use. Hand sanitizer provided in each bathroom. Toilet seat covers available.
12. We will sing but will limit live singing to two songs near the end of worship with masks on. Use recorded acapella music if needed early in the service.
13. The entire worship period should be limited to about 40 minutes.
14. Contribution will be handled online, by mail or with offering box placed toward the back of auditorium.
15. Individual communion kits will be picked up on entering.
16. Improved ventilation will be provided -- auditorium fan on continuous run. HVAC servicing auditorium provided with REME HALO UV system.
17. Dismiss by rows from the back after worship. Exit to outside aisles. Everyone but ushers depart the foyer immediately.
18. Contact tracing, if necessary, will be aided by taking a picture of the congregation at the start and conclusion of worship.
19. Initially limit attendance to 25% of capacity; about 100 people per service.
20. Re-open after GA DPH daily 7-day new case moving average for Clarke County is below 30 trending down.
21. No Sunday School, Glory Garden, Nursery or “Coins” Procession
22. Service will be recorded and uploaded to YouTube Sunday afternoon.
